You must be over 18 years of age to participate in facility based (hospital, group home, shelter) activities, and in some cases you may need to have a background check. Most facilities limit visiting volunteer groups to 5 people.

Events – Provide volunteers for a booth or to help out at one of our many public events! You will receive signage at the event, and your employees will take an active part in helping raise funds or create fun for children in Southeast Florida in need of a smile!

Wish Lists – Collect toys, adopt a children’s facility for the holidays and shop specifically for their children, or help fulfill a wish list for a special local child at any time during the year. We have lots of ideas on how to tie participation to on-the-job perks to get everyone engaged.

Junk Food Runs – Go shopping for fun food for a local pediatric emergency room for traumatized children and families that need comfort and sustenance...then help us deliver it! A fun, hands on way to create little smiles.

Fundraising – Provide special snacks or meals during the course of the workday where the proceeds go to Little Smiles, or sponsor fun competitions between departments with matching donation challenges. Little Smiles representatives and kids impacted by our program can come to you and help expand understanding of just how important a little smile can be.

Parties – Little Smiles hosts regular pizza parties, end of chemo parties, movie nights and more! These events generally accommodate just one to two employees at a time. Volunteer groups can commit to helping on these events on a monthly basis at a particular facility, rotating among staff members and providing a deeper connection to the work of Little Smiles.
